Dear Mr. McCoy:

This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request received by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) on November 1, 2010, wherein you requested "incident reports, witness summaries and documents called Memorandum for Record that were created on September 18, 19 and 20, 2009 at the International Airport located in Dallas- Fort Worth, Texas." However, in a subsequent email, the request was amended to cover records pertaining only to yourself and any involvement with the TSA for the specified time period.

A comprehensive search for records was conducted within the Office of Security Operations and the Federal Security Director of the Dallas-Ft. Worth Airport, for records that would be responsive to your request. Unfortunately, we were unable to locate or identify any responsive records.


**Administrative Appeal**

While an adequate search was conducted, you have the right to appeal this determination that no records exist within the Office of Security Operations or with the Federal Security Director of the Dallas-Ft. Worth Airport that would be responsive to your request.

In the event that you may wish to appeal this determination, an administrative appeal may be made in writing to Kimberly Walton, Special Counselor, Office of the Special Counselor, Transportation Security Administration, 601 South 12<sup>th</sup> Street, East Building, E7-121S, Arlington, VA 20598-6033. Your appeal **must be submitted within 60 days** from the date of this determination. It should contain your FOIA request number and state, to the extent possible, the reasons why you believe the initial determination should be reversed. In addition, the envelope in which the appeal is mailed in should be prominently marked "FOIA Appeal."
